(B) CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION ISSUED

During the period 1 May 2013 to 30 April 2014, 199 persons were issued registration and a full licence to practise. In total there were 216 certificates issued of which 14 were for a resident licence. Three physicians did not practise here.

33.9% of fully licensed physicians are female. 34.2% of practitioners in Winnipeg are women, 26.6% in Brandon and 34.7% in rural Manitoba. 63% of those with a residency licence are female. During the past 32 years there has been an increase of 482 women in Winnipeg, 26 in Brandon and 137 in the remainder of the province.
