PROCLAMATION


College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba 150th Anniversary

- WHEREAS** the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba protects the public as consumers of medical care and promotes the safe and ethical delivery of quality medical care by physicians in Manitoba; and
- WHEREAS** on May 3, 1871, the Manitoba Medical Act established The Provincial Medical Board of Manitoba during the first Legislative Assembly of Manitoba with 15 new members registered during the five-year term of the board; and
- WHEREAS** in 1877, the name was changed to The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba; and
- WHEREAS** in 2019, The Regulated Health Professions Act was enacted and provides legislated authority for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba; and
- WHEREAS** today, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba has over 4,000 members, and membership is mandatory for all physicians, clinical assistants, physician assistants, medical residents and medical students to practice medicine in Manitoba; and
- WHEREAS** the Manitoba government congratulates the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba and its members on 150 years of promoting and providing safe, ethical and quality medical care for Manitobans;

Now therefore let it be known that I, **Heather Stefanson, Minister of Health and Seniors Care** for the Province of Manitoba, do hereby proclaim May 3, 2021, as
