Medical Consultant – Quality Improvement Program

The College of Physicians & Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) is inviting applications for individuals who have an interest in being a part of the Quality Improvement Program (QIP). The ideal applicant will have excellent verbal and written communication skills, experience with applying and evaluating physician risk rubrics and a problem-solving approach that incorporates a client centered approach. This will include providing evaluations, education, feedback and support to physicians going through the QIP process.

This is a part time position (0.6 EFT) with the main duties of the position to include: completing file reviews on a physician participant cohort, assisting with overseeing the operations of the QIP as well as actively evaluating and improving the Quality Improvement Program processes and policies. Consulting with similar programs across the country this position will ensure best practices are employed in the QIP and are in compliance with the Regulated Health Professions Act, CPSM Bylaws, Standards of Practice, Practice Directions and Code of Ethics as required.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate must hold a Medical Degree and must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. The successful candidate will have at least seven (7) years' experience in family medicine or other specialty practice.

CPSM offers a comprehensive benefits package and a salary range has been established. Individuals will be placed in a range commensurate with qualifications and experience.
