

Attending an application for Reinstatement Hearing

Hearings are Open to the Public

All applications for reinstatement hearings are open to the public, subject to the right of the Executive Committee to order that the public be excluded from all or part of the hearing.

Where the Executive Committee determines that the public should be excluded from the hearing or any part of it, the Executive Committee must provide written reasons, and those reasons must be made available to the public.

Hearings are held in person at the CPSM office at 1000- 1661 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg.
